CMC Leadville's High School Equivalency program uses a flexible model that offers morning classes, evening classes, individualized instruction, and online support. For a non-refundable course fee of \$75.00 per semester, students can attend all sessions or choose the sessions that will work with their schedule. Class times are Monday mornings from 9:30-12:00 and Wednesday evenings from 6:30-9:00. Tutoring is available Mondays-Thursdays 10 a.m.- 8:00 p.m. in the Student Success Center and meetings with the instructor are Thursdays from 6:00-9:00 p.m. GED, HiSET, and TASC exams can all be used to earn the High School Equivalency Diploma from the Colorado Department of Education.
