In Kind Contributions

In Kind contributions are gifts of goods or services to our program.

To count as In Kind, goods must be something that has purpose or value to the program that the program would normally pay for if it was not donated.

Non-Federal Match

Head Start is a federally funded grant program. As a requirement of receiving the grant money, our program is required to obtain a 25% match from In Kind contributions. If our match is not met, our program loses operating funds.

How much do we need?

For 2019-2020, the amount we must raise for our match is \$153,017p.00.

That seems like a lot of money, and it is... but we are very fortunate to enjoy a high level of support from our community and the families we serve.

Much of this amount we receive through donated services from Lake County School District and other local agencies, such as lake County Public Health for blood lead testing, Full Circle for parenting classes, Ski Cooper for the ski program, the Trail 100 Legacy Foundation, and Leadville/Lake County Fire Rescue.
