Administrative Organization

The legal authority of the Board is transmitted through the superintendent pursuant to its executive limitation, board/staff relationship and ends policies.

The superintendent shall have freedom to organize lines of authority within the school district to facilitate reasonable progress toward achievement of the Board's ends and to accommodate the elimination and creation of positions.

In order to protect the Board from sudden loss of the superintendent's services, the superintendent shall have no fewer than one other executive familiar with Board and superintendent issues and process.
