

Community Involvement in Decision Making

Parents are always welcome to come to the school for any reason and are encouraged to do so. Parents must go to the principal's office before visitation, identify themselves and indicate their wishes with regard to visitation.

When parents want to discuss a problem with a teacher, they must first make arrangements with the principal and identify themselves. The principal shall make the necessary arrangements with the teacher or teachers involved for a conference at a time agreed upon mutually.

When parents have problems involving the principal, they shall first come to the superintendent and identify themselves and the problem involved. The superintendent shall make the necessary arrangements for a conference with those concerned at a time agreed upon mutually.

When parents have problems involving the superintendent the Board requests that they first contact the Board and identify themselves and the problem and make arrangements for a conference involving the superintendent, the parent or parents involved, and the Board.
