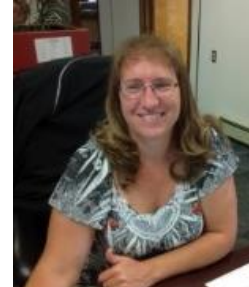


Paul oversees operational areas for the district, including finance, information technology, federal funding, human capital, and operations. He is the contact for budget questions, feedback or ideas to make our district better.

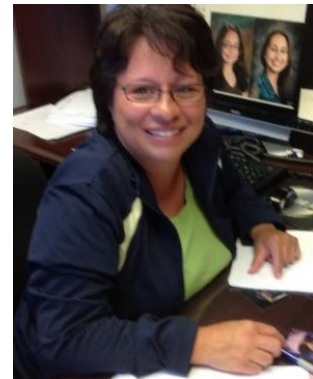


Noreen is responsible for all position postings, payroll, benefits, and licensure questions for employees. Noreen also maintains our student/staff data for state reporting.

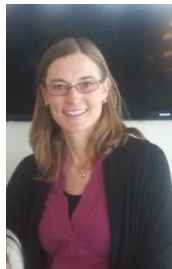

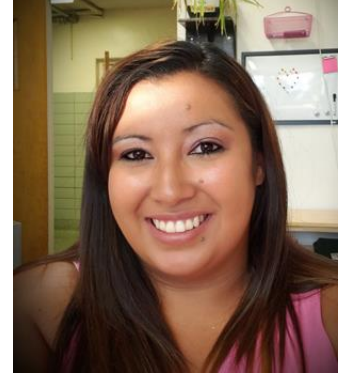
