Dear Parents, Students, Teachers, and Building Occupants,

In 1986, Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requiring schools to inspect and identify any asbestos-containing building materials (ACBM). Lake County School District R-1 hired a certified building inspector to identify and sample any suspect asbestos-containing building materials.

The law further requires the school to have an asbestos management plan. Lake County High School, Lake County Intermediate School, West Park Elementary School, and Pitts Elementary School have an asbestos management plan available for review in the school district administrative office or the administrative office of the school during regular business hours. Todd Coffin is our designated asbestos program coordinator, and all inquiries regarding the asbestos plan and asbestos-related issues should be directed to Todd Coffin at 719-486-6815.

Updates for the year:

This last school Year, (2019-2020) there was no ACBM removed from any of the schools. The school maintenance staff inspected the condition of the materials every six months and the condition of the material remains in good condition. Next school year, (2020-2021) we will demolishing West Park School. No other ACBM is scheduled for removal in any of the other schools.
